Mrs. Griggs teaches Music class. You will have fun singing, dancing, playing instruments and learning all about music with her, because *Kindergarten matters*






This is the school gym where you will keep your body healthy by playing fun games. Ms. Evans will teach your Gym class, because *Kindergarten matters*.
