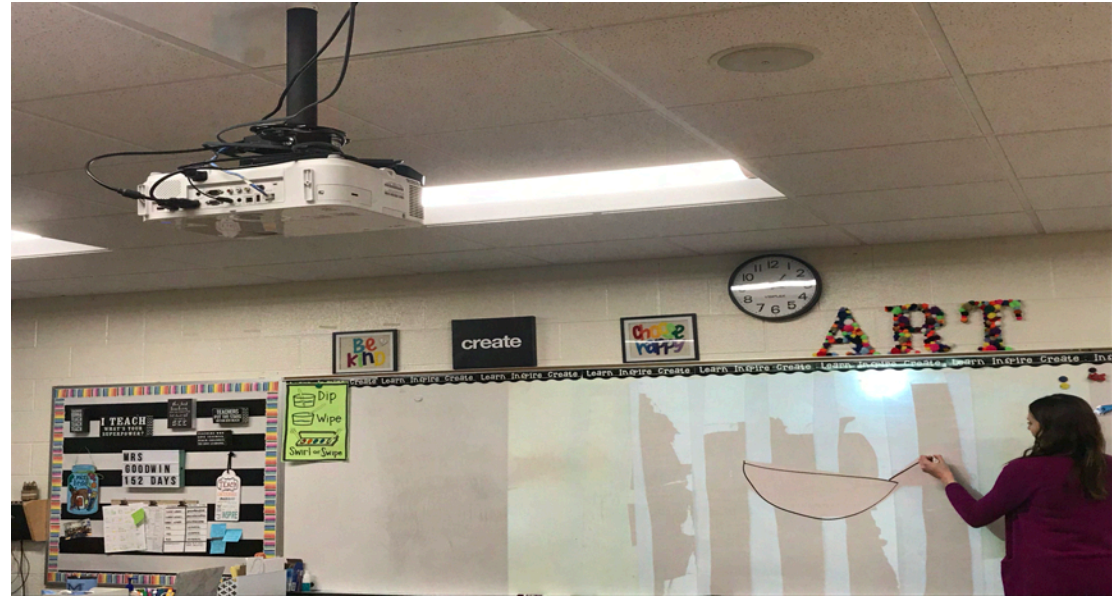
Mrs. Kindy and Mrs. Kreuger are the speech teachers here at Meridian. You might see one of them visiting your Kindergarten classroom.
