

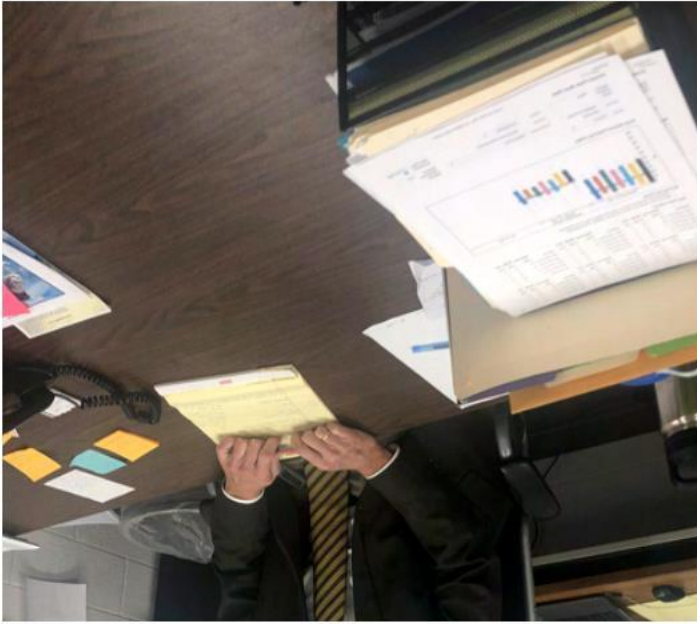
Woodcrest Elementary School Welcomes You to Kindergarten!
